

Letty's Purse: Menu of Suggested Projects

These are just a suggestion to get you started—we will entertain ideas for individual projects too!

Letty's Purse Process:

Present written application outlining your provisional "Pay it Forward" project to Mr. & Mrs. Kluttz.

They will discuss your project with you, and

- Accept the project as is, OR
- Ask for further clarification on the project, and give a deadline to get the information back to them;

AND

- Accept the amount as requested, OR
- Change the amount requested

At the end of your meeting, Mr. & Mrs. Kluttz will give you a copy of the "Pay it Forward" Completion Form.

Once your project has been provisionally accepted, and any changes or clarifications provided, start your work!

When you've finished, make sure your Completion Form is filled in, and turn it in to Mrs. Sullivan, and your award will be made.

Suggested Menu of Options

Little (Choose 3-4)

- Bake cookies for elderly, sick or shut-in neighbors
- Help an elderly, sick or shut-in neighbor with errands or chores
- Choose two active military personnel and write each one of them two letters.

- Gather food, paper goods or children's clothing and take them to Wesley Community Center, 1601 Drayton Street, Phone 236-4226
- Clean up a park, street or playground two different weeks, and make a sign that says "Please Don't Litter"

at Hospice Savannah or a retirement home

You must confirm that you may perform there, provide the name of the facility, a contact name and phone number, outline any training required before going on site, and a date.

- Host a Car Wash with 1-2 other Letty's Purse applicants.

OR

Medium (Choose 2)

- Research and write a report on a composer whose work we're singing or the author of the text in a song we're singing. Present your report to the SCC.
- Ask SCC staff, board members, or people you know who travel to donate travel size shampoo, lotion, soap, etc. Make up 5 bags of these items, and deliver them to people in a nursing home or shelter.

- Help your school or church music program. Provide up to 3 hours of volunteer service, filing music, sorting materials, or whatever jobs your music director assigns you.

You must clear this ahead of time and provide your music teacher's name and phone number as part of your application!

You must provide the name of the car wash location, a contact name and number, and an outline of who will provide what materials (soap, buckets, hose, sign, etc.)

- Host a Bake Sale with 1-2 other Letty's Purse applicants.

You must provide the name of the location, a contact name and number, and an outline of who will provide what items.

OR

Big (Choose 1)

- Coordinate a concert with 1-2 other Letty's Purse applicants
